

General English Main Course: Intensive

Our Intensive Course consists of 25 lessons. This is equivalent to 20 hours and 50 minutes, 20 of these lessons follow the same programme as the main course. The other 5 are taught in the afternoon. These afternoon lessons build language to help students communicate at lower language levels and give lots of communication practice to higher level learners.

Why take Main Course Intensive English?

Our *Main Course Intensive* is a general English language improvement course which teaches students how to use English to communicate effectively in speaking and writing.

Lesson content of this course is based on an up to date course book and supplementary materials and activities provided by the teacher.

Enrolment is open and students can join this course most Mondays throughout the year (excluding bank holidays).

- We will test you before you start so you are placed in a class of the right level

- If your course is longer than 4 weeks, you will have a 15-minute one-to-one tutorial with a teacher or the head of studies every 4 weeks.
- You will receive a certificate at the end of your course
